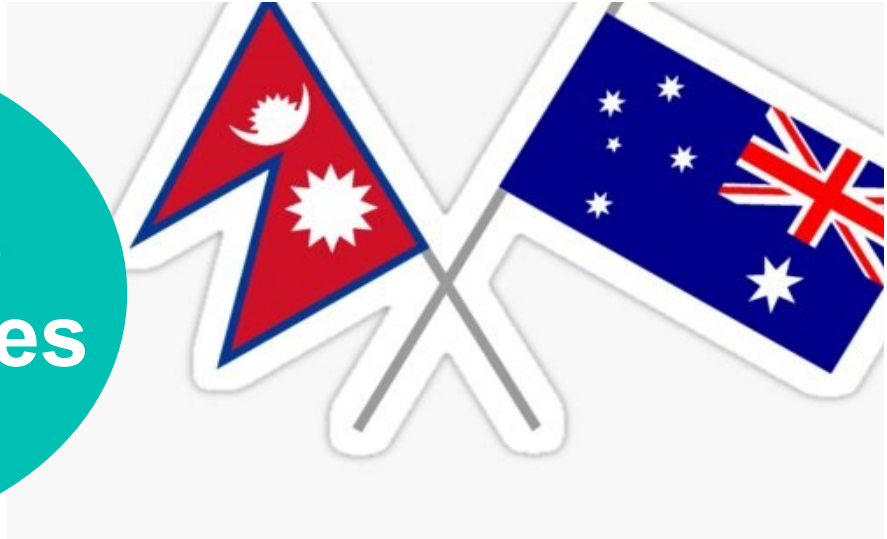


Cardinia Nepalese Communities Group
