- Help with school uniform and school essentials costs
- Support to build a strong relationship with childcare, kinder and/or school
- Access to speech pathology and psycho educational assessments to support children's development and achievement
- Information, advice and referrals
- Linking to services such as GP, maternal health nurse etc.
