A parenting support program for children aged 6 weeks to 5 years.

What is Newpin?

The New Parent Infant Network (Newpin) is a centrebased parenting program, which provides an interactive and supportive approach to enhancing parent-child relationships. Newpin supports parents and children's social and emotional development through individual and group work programs that support parents to build their self-esteem and confidence in parenting.

What does the program offer?

- One on one parenting support
- Information about your child's development
- Parent education groups on topics such as sleep, fussy eating, behavior management
- Individual play groups
- Getting to know other parents with children of similar age

Attendance at Newpin is voluntary. Newpin staff will work individually with you to help identify what parenting goals you would like to work on. You can attend Newpin twice a week and can access support for up to 1 year dependent on your needs.

How do I get into Newpin?

If transport to the program is difficult for you, Newpin staff are able to pick you up and transport you and your child/ren to and from the centre.

What does the program offer?

Parents with children, aged up to 5 years that are experiencing parenting challenges.
